Fact and Instruction Sheet 2022 Mineral Area K-12 Art Show and Competition Sponsored by Mineral Area Council on the Arts (MACOA) at Mineral Area College (MAC)

- 1. **Purpose:** To provide an opportunity for Mineral Area art students and teachers to display their original artwork and to promote the visual arts in general.
- 2. Where: Robert Sechrest Sr. Field House, Mineral Area College, Park Hills, MO.

3. **When:** Wed., April 27, through Fri., April 29, 2022.

Wednesday, April 27 Installation of artwork by teachers @ Noon to 6:30 PM. Thursday, April 28 Judging @ 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM; no public viewing.

Friday, April 29 Field trips @ 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM.

Public viewing @ 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM;

Presentation of awards at 7:00 PM;

Removal of all artwork at 7:00 PM/after the awards.

- 4. **Who may participate:** Students currently enrolled in public schools, all organized private/parochial schools, and any home schools in the Mineral Area.
- 5. **Divisions and Categories:** There are five grade-divisions (Grades 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12) in each of the following twelve media-categories:

Ceramics Open Media: 3-D

Design Open Media: 2-D (should have only

height and width; no depth)

Digital (should be printed, *no* Painting

electronic devices may be used in

display)

Drawing-Black & White Photography
Drawing-Color Printmaking
Fibers Sculpture/3D

Display Only (Entries welcomed but not judged):

Grades K-2 all categories except Design;

Group Projects (2 or more students working on one piece);

Teachers' Artwork.

6. Entry criteria:

- a. Each school will be limited to a maximum of <u>five</u> entries per category per division.
- b. Home schools will be limited to one entry per category per division.
- c. All original artwork must have been completed during the 2021-2022 school year and should have been done under the <u>supervision and observation of the teacher</u>. If you are submitting work that has been done during an after-school class or an art club that you sponsor and supervise, please integrate any of those pieces into your regular-classroom allotment as part of your five entries per category per division.

- d. "Original" is artwork that is created by the student (without being a direct facsimile of another's album cover, painting, etc) developed from a student's imagination, inspiration, and personality.
 - We understand that at the K-12 level it can be more feasible to learn to draw or paint from a photograph taken by another person, such as images of people or animals in a magazine. As such, we will accept paintings and drawings based on another person's photograph.
 - Copies of another artist's copyrighted work, designs or illustrations are not acceptable (ie, logos, cartoon or comic book characters, etc)
 - Purchased kits are not acceptable.
- e. Suggested interpretations for this art show:

<u>Ceramics</u> – Functional object designed by firing a non-metal mineral such as clay. <u>Design</u> – Work in which visual or abstract ideas predominate, using colors and materials according to a plan.

<u>Digital</u> - Original two-dimensional work created on digital technology and *printed* to include drawing, illustration, and painting but not photography, graphic art poster, animation, or 3D prints (must be prepared to provide a psd file with original sketch upon request)

<u>Drawing</u> – The use of two-dimensional media to express emotion and feeling. Fibers – Weaving, yarn art, baskets, etc.

<u>Open Media</u> – Includes media not already categorized, e.g. graphic arts, collage, mixed media.

Painting – Includes oils, acrylics, watercolor, etc.

<u>Photography</u> – Photos modified through use of lens, filter, developing, and computer.

<u>Printmaking</u> – Mark made on a surface by pressing or stamping.

<u>Sculpture/3D</u> – Original subtractive or additive work, which can be multi-media; clay, wood, metal, paper, cardboard, recyclables, etc.

7. **Batteries/Electricity:** We <u>cannot</u> accept any pieces that use batteries or electricity. There are few electrical outlets in the field house, and we cannot be responsible for turning on and off or plugging in and unplugging pieces.

8. Entry Procedures:

- a. All hanging artwork must be suspended using the binder clip-plus-paperclip method; we will supply both kinds of clips with guidance on how to use them.
- b. Entries may be matted or mounted to make a better showing.
- c. Please <u>legibly fill in the enclosed tag correctly</u> and securely attach it to the lower right-hand corner of the piece.
- d. No frames with glass are accepted as this is a hazard.
- e. All paintings, drawing, prints, and other mounted work shall be no larger than 30" x 24"; any 3D pieces shall be no larger than 48"x48"x48".
- f. Any art pieces that are displayed larger than the above listed dimensions, can be displayed, but not judged. Please notify MACOA ahead of the show that you'll be bringing oversized work
- g. Please plan to install your students' artwork on Wed., April 27, before **6:30 PM**.

h. Please use the enclosed form to <u>submit a list of all work that you plan to enter</u> in the art show. We would like to have that information by Friday, April 22, 2022, so that we can prepare enough display space. Please <u>send your lists</u> of student work to Scottye Adkins via email (<u>sadkins@mineralarea.edu</u>) or deliver to MAC, Fine Arts Room 134.

9. Judging and Awards:

- a. Two <u>Best of Show</u> awards will be given, one for the best three-dimensional work and the other for the best two-dimensional work in all grade divisions. Each Best of Show student will receive **\$100 cash** and an extra-fancy ribbon. The Best of Show teachers will each receive \$150 for classroom use.
- b. Five <u>Award for Excellence</u> students (one award for each grade division) will each receive **\$50 cash** and a fancy ribbon. The Award of Excellence teachers will each be given \$100 for classroom use.
- c. All other artwork that is entered in the show will receive a First Place, Second Place, Third Place, Fourth Place or Exhibitor ribbon; all artwork that is displayed at the art show has already "won" at the classroom/school level.
- 10. **Censorship:** Prior to submitting a piece for judging or display, please assess the content to decide whether it is appropriate for display in a family-oriented setting, where pre-school and kindergarten children will be seeing the work. Any exhibit deemed inappropriate by the committee will be removed. All decisions are final.

11. Miscellaneous:

- a. Please help us publicize this event by notifying your local news media.
- b. Installation: If you're unable to set up your own artwork at the designated time, please notify Scottye at 573-518-2125 or sadkins@mineralarea.edu to make other arrangements.
- c. **Disclaimer:** Regrettably, neither MACOA nor MAC can be responsible for any damage or loss that might occur.
- d. Please plan to remove all artwork and ribbons from the fieldhouse immediately after the awards ceremony so we can break down the display structures and clean up. **We cannot be responsible for unclaimed work after the show's clean-up on Friday.**
